Medico-legal Practice:

Personal Injury:

The bulk of reports that I prepare are for noise induced hearing loss and amount to about 100 per year on average.

In addition I undertake reports in the field to occupational rhinitis. As the Honorary advisor to British Chrome and Chemicals (now known as Elementis Chromium) I tend to see cases caused by exposure to chemicals, adhesives, and occasionally biological dusts such as tea dust.

I have a special interest in balance disorders. This means that I prepare reports on balance disturbances. These are usually cases that arise out of head injuries. Many of these cases are related to issues of employability.

I am regularly retained by both plaintiff (60%) and defence (40%) firms. I also undertake work for insurance companies including, Zurich, Iron Trades, Eagle Star and Legal and General.

Medical Negligence:

Medical negligence cases are rare in otolaryngology. Nevertheless, I have advised on over 150 cases in a 15 year period. I provide reports for both plaintiff and defence firms. The split would be approximately 60% for plaintiff and 40 % for defence organisations and firms.

Regulation:

Fortunately allegations of serious professional misconduct in otolaryngology are very unusual. I have provided expert opinion to the New Zealand Medical Council, South African Medical Council and our own General Medical Council.

Court Experience:

I attend court to give oral evidence on average once or twice a year over the last ten years. In addition to giving evidence in court, I have experience of giving evidence to medical tribunals and the Serious Professional Misconduct Committee of the General Medical Council.

In conjunction with Park Court Chambers in Leeds and Hempsons, I have run four Witness Skills courses

I ran a twice-yearly communication skills course for doctors until 2001.
